





### **PICK UP LOCATION AND DEPARTURE**

Customers are advised to be at their departure location 10 minutes prior to departure. As we have several locations to pick up from, your coach will depart your location at the stated times. If you are not at the departure location, we will endeavour to contact you by phone to find out where you are. Please ensure that you have supplied your mobile phone number. If you fail to arrive by the departure time, you will forfeit your seat on the coach and any monies paid.

### **HEALTH AND SAFETY**

We follow the government guidelines to ensure the health of our valued customers. To ensure the safety of our customers, we ask that if you are unwell, please stay home. Passengers who develop signs of illness whilst on an extended tour will be required to wear a mask.

### **PAYMENT**

No payment is required when initially booking your tour, and you can book your tours and reserve your seats for the whole year. Payment for your day tours needs to be paid in full 14 days before departure unless otherwise stated, and 30 days before departure on all extended tours. If payment is not paid by the required date, your seat will be made available to our waitlisted passengers. Emails will be sent to remind customers that payment is due.

### **CANCELLATIONS**
