The Year Ahead

This year's book includes some layout changes. You will notice we have grouped the metro trips together, along with out-of-town trips, shopping, and event days. We have also included a few new suggestions that will definitely be of interest to social groups and clubs.

There have been many changes across the industry over the past twelve to eighteen months. We have done our very best to stay up to date, and as a result, you may notice a few updates in this year's book. We have tried to keep these changes to a minimum but some venues have updated their policies and operations, and we need to align with these changes too.

One of the most notable updates is that some venues now require deposits to secure bookings for lunches. You will see this noted throughout the book to help make your decision making as smooth as possible.

Confirming Numbers

We know plans can change but to keep everything running smoothly, we need final guest numbers and lunch orders at least seven days before your trip. You will receive a lunch order form when you book; just fill it in with guest names and their order, return it and we will take care of the rest. We cannot accept a nameless list anymore.

Minimum Numbers

To book one of our full size coaches, we need at least 24 guests. For smaller groups, we use a comfortable mid-size bus to help keep costs down. Some clubs have had great success teaming up with others and we are always happy to help make that happen.

Travel Club

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THE SWAN VALLEY TOURS

SWAN VALLEY FOODIE TOUR | TOUR ID 2601

Discover the best of the Swan Valley with us. We'll explore as much of this stunning region as time allows, beginning with morning tea at The Lavender Bistro, where you'll enjoy a tasting plate with tea or coffee. Then it's on to The House of Honey for a sweet experience before travelling to Pasta in the Valley for a delicious lunch. After lunch we'll call in at Yahava KoffeeWorks to watch coffee roasting and sample some of their finest brews. To end the day on a sweet note, you choose your final stop Mondo Nougat, Morish Nuts, Whistler's Chocolate or the Margaret River Chocolate Co. A perfect day of indulgence and discovery awaits.

A DAY AT WHITEMAN PARK | TOUR ID 2602

Today we head straight to Caversham Wildlife Park for morning tea and a leisurely walk around the park seeing all the iconic Australian Wildlife. We will also have our morning tea here as well. Some highlights are Wombat and friends encounter and Molly's Farm. We then head to the Whiteman Park Cafe for a two course lunch with tea and coffee (no set dessert; we can choose from the cabinet.) After our lunch, there's time to wander the village to see local arts and crafts and the lolly shop (please note some opening times vary). Then we can hop on the coach for a visit to Revolutions Museum, a great place detailing the transport history of Perth and Western Australia.

Today begins in Guildford with morning tea at Stirling Square, right in the heart of the town. After tea, we visit the Swan Valley Visitor Centre to view the Cradle of the Colony exhibition, then pop next door to the Historical Society and Colonial Gaol (open Wednesday and Friday or by appointment if volunteers are available). Time for lunch! We drive to Pasta in the Valley for a two-course meal. If time allows, we'll sneak in a visit to the Margaret River Chocolate Factory before heading back, giving you a sweet finish to a historic day.

SWAN VALLEY WINE TOUR | TOUR ID 2604

The Swan Valley is famous around the world for its wines so let's head out there and enjoy them! We will start our day with a self tasting at Lancaster Winery, including a grazing board for our morning tea and of course the views of the vines and valley. From there we head to the impressive Mandoon Estate for a guided tasting. Time for lunch! Valley Social will be our venue for a two course meal, (drinks will be at your own expense here). Our last winery is Olive Farm Wines where we will have a hosted tasting. Finally we head to Whistlers Chocolate, a true staple of the Valley and Rove Charters & Elite Tours!

TOODYAY & GOMBOC GALLERY | TOUR ID 2605

After lunch, enjoy free time in town to explore attractions such as the Christmas Shop, Coca-Cola Museum, Connor's Mill and the Visitor Centre before returning to the city. Lunch offers time to soak up the authentic country atmosphere of this much-loved tavern. This facility is part of the Goldfields Water Supply Scheme, designed by CY O'Connor to transfer water from Perth's hills to Western Australia's goldfields across 560 kilometres. The scheme opened in 1903 and remains an engineering marvel. After the tour, we enjoy a two-course lunch at the historic Mundaring Hotel with tea and coffee. If time permits, we'll stop at Whistler's Chocolate Factory for sweet treats. *(Please provide two preferred dates when booking as we coordinate access with Trust. Booking is not confirmed until this is complete)*

STRINGYBARK WINERY | TOUR ID 2608
